Located directly east of the Salt Palace Convention Center and one block from the Radisson, you'll find the City Creek Center, opening March, 2012.

City Creek is a sustainably designed, walkable urban community of residences, offices, restaurants and retail stores, on approximately 20 acres across three blocks in the heart of downtown Salt Lake City. Upon project completion in 2012, the city will be one of few in the nation with a vibrant, mixed-use development at its core.

Gateway Mall

The Gateway is Salt Lake City's only open-air contemporary destination that delivers the ultimate in shopping, dining, and entertainment. Shop and dine at over 130 stores and restaurants. The Gateway is located only two blocks from the Radisson.

Visit the beautifully restored 1908 Union Pacific Depot featuring early French Renaissance architecture and original artwork. Also, enjoy the Olympic Legacy Plaza featuring the "dancing waters" of the Olympic Snowflake Fountain that is overlooked by a classic clock tower.
