There is a worldwide need for expertise in the career and technical education (CTE) field. Countries from around the world currently have billions of dollars worth of projects that need CTE expertise, yet few of these opportunities are going to U.S. entities.

The Association for Career and Technical Education (ACTE) recently developed an international consortium that launched a Web-based database that seeks to publicize existing opportunities and bring together U.S. entities in an effort to successfully bid for these projects.

As part of the International TVET Consortium's objectives, it will be offering a workshop on March 10, 2010, from 12:00 p.m.–5:00 p.m., that will not only share existing opportunities, but will bring together funding agencies to explain how U.S. entities can successfully secure these projects.
