Note: Percentage cuts vary due to the impact of the "hold harmless" and "ratable reduction" provisions of the Perkins Act formula that related to 1998 funding levels. Since this cut is below those levels, all states were reduced to their 1998 allocation, and then cut by an equal rate from there. States that were higher above their 1998 levels received a larger cut.
