One Size Fits All? Not for Personal Finance

University Plaza - John Q Room

Personal Finance is a required course in Missouri for graduation for all students including SPED and ELL. Diversity in classrooms is increasing. Each student's unique cultural background may render assumptions made by curriculum developers problematic which complicates the learning process. An ELL personal finance student is challenged with learning the English language along with the language of personal finance. Research strongly suggests that students experience difficulty comprehending content when they are not familiar with the vocabulary and cannot relate it to background knowledge. SPED students have their own unique challenges for learning. How does the classroom teacher help these students succeed? Operation Outreach and MCEE have partnered to develop professional development for teachers that will help them recognize the unique needs of the diverse populations and how to incorporate best practices for these students. One size does not fit all.
