Educating Today's Students for a World Their Teachers Cannot Imagine

Summary: This fall, 96 individuals will start medical school at the University of Missouri. Hopefully, all of them will graduate in 2011 and they will complete their residencies in 2014 to 2016. Our faculty cannot imagine what medical practice will be like in 2016, yet we must prepare our future doctors. This is not unique to medicine because all educators must be futurists. Are store clerks, bank tellers, and postal workers going to be extinct replaced by on-line shopping, ATMs and e-mail? This is already occurring. New diseases such as bird flu, Legionella, strains of e. coli, drug resistant tuberculosis, West Nile disease have become prominent in the past decade and global warming may mean new diseases caused by mutating pathogens. The human genome project, stem cell research and advances in organ transplants may provide major changes in quality of life and possibly life expectancy. We cannot be content teaching today's knowledge to tomorrow's leaders. It is a world of ill-defined problems and we must teach our students to be problem solvers.
