CONSTITUTION OF THE

NEW YORK STATE ASSOCIATION for CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this organization shall be the New York State Association for Career & Technical Education, hereinafter referred to as *The Association*.

ARTICLE II - SCOPE

- **A.** To assume and maintain active leadership in the promotion, further development, and extension of **career and technical education**.
- **B.** To serve as a unifying agency for all interests in **career and technical education** in the State of New York.
- **C.** To provide an opportunity for a state-wide exchange of ideas on all aspects of, and problems involved in, **career and technical education.**
- **D.** To develop and promote **career and technical education** as an integral part of the total educational program in the State of New York.
- **E.** To act as a central agency for keeping the state and national legislators, other educational organizations, and the people clearly and reliably informed on the purposes, needs, and accomplishments of **career and technical education** programs in the State.
- **F.** To cooperate with the programs of national associations and organizations for the promotion and extenuation of **career and technical education programs**.
- **G.** To be affiliated with and cooperate with the programs of the Association for Career and Technical Education..
- **H.** To promote active participation in youth organizations in **career and technical education** programs.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

All persons in accordance with the provisions as stated in the **By-Laws** shall be eligible for membership.

ARTICLE IV - DUES

Dues for membership shall be established in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE V - STRUCTURE

The Association shall be composed of an Executive Board and an Advisory Council. The composition of the Executive Board and Advisory Council shall be established in the **By-Laws**.

ARTICLE VI - EXECUTIVE BOARD

The Executive Board shall be the governing body of The Association and shall consist of the officers.

ARTICLE VII - OFFICERS

The officers of *The Association* shall be the President, Immediate Past President, ??President-Elect, Treasurer and Secretary.

ARTICLE VIII - ADVISORY COUNCIL

The *Advisory Council* shall be established to offer counsel and advice to the President and the *Executive Board*.

ARTICLE IX - MEETINGS

- A. The Executive Board shall meet four (4) times a year. 3 or 4??
- **B.** The *Advisory Council* shall meet in conjunction with the *Executive Board*.
- **C.** The *Annual Business Meeting* of *The Association* shall be held once a year at such a time and place as the *Executive Board* shall decide. **??Have not done??**
- **D.** Other meetings, including conferences, may be called at the discretion of the *Executive Board*.

ARTICLE X - AMENDMENTS

- **A.** Proposed amendments to the *Constitution* shall be submitted in writing to the *Executive Board* by any member 120 days prior to the *Annual Business Meeting*.
- **B.** The *Executive Board* shall transmit said amendments to the *Advisory Council* for input no later than 60 days prior to the *Annual Business Meeting*.
- **C.** The *Constitution* may be revised or amended by a two-thirds vote of all members present and voting at the *Annual Business Meeting*.
- **D.** Constitutional revisions or amendments shall become effective 30 days from the date approved at the *Annual Business Meeting*.

ARTICLE XI - PROCEDURE

The business of *The Association* shall be conducted according to *Robert's Rules* of *Order, Revised*, unless otherwise specified in this *Constitution* or the *By-Laws*.

ARTICLE XII - DISSOLUTION

In the event of the dissolution of *The Association*, the assets of *The Association* shall be distributed to the members of *The Association* on a proportionate share based on active membership in *The Association* and who are in good standing at the time of dissolution.

ARTICLE XIII - BY-LAWS

The **By-Laws** of *The Association* shall be consistent with the **Constitution**.
