\$15 - Morton Arboretum – Troll Hunt <http://www.mortonarb.org/>

The Morton Arboretum's 1,700 acres hold more than 222,000 live plants representing nearly 4,300 taxa from around the world. On this tour journey through the far-reaching forest to hunt for six colossal trolls crafted from reclaimed wood by Danish artist Thomas Dambo. Marvel at these 15- to 30-foot-tall (and one 60-foot long) sculptures that have been created to serve as protectors of our environment. The Arboretum champions the world's trees through plant collections, science and conservation, education, and outreach. (Join the adventure and pick up the *Troll Hunter's Handbook* when you arrive. The *Handbook* will help you find a clue for each troll to locate the Troll's secret hideout, complete with a troll-size toothbrush and other troll essentials.)

\$4 - Giant Steps <http://www.mygiantsteps.org/> and Cantigny McCormick House

Giant Steps has been focused on providing education, therapeutic and recreational programs for elementary, junior high and high school students with Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD). Giant Steps is a therapeutic day school in the State of Illinois licensed and certified to exclusively serve students with a primary diagnosis of autism. The tour will take us through the entire facility and discuss the many services that this educational organization provides to its clients. **Cantigny McCormick House** is a historic house museum that depicts the country home of a family that made the Chicago Tribune the "World's Greatest Newspaper."
