- 1. You must have 2 or more years of experience
- 2. Must be a member of a division, NCACTE and ACTE
- 3. You must obtain permission from your principal and CTE director.
- 4. Must commit to complete the entire program.
- 5. You must have a sincere interest in NCACTE and its leadership.
- 6. You must have a strong desire to move the association forward as a potential leader.

Requirements:

- 1. Attend the Fall and Spring NCACTE Professional Development Seminars
- 2. Attend CTE Summer Conference
- 3. Attend the Region II conference in Raleigh, NC in October
- 4. Assist the NCACTE staff during the vendor show and registration on Monday night and Tuesday as needed during Summer conference.
- 5. Attend the Officer/board training session at Summer Conference on Tuesday.
- 6. Serve on a division/state level committee.
- 7. Become an NCACTE Membership Recruitment Ambassador
- 8.Read 2 books on Leadership. One as a book study and one as pleasure.
- 9. Interview NCACTE president/NCACTE Executive director or someone from the CTE division at the Department of Public Instruction.
- 10. Create an NCACTE membership recruitment video, individually or as a group.
- 11. Create reflective writings as required throughout the experience.

- 2. How to manage a division/state association.
- 3. Marketing your associations
- 4. Branding: Ways to increase awareness of the association and its benefits.
- 5. Moving the association forward using your acquired leadership skills.
