Supporting Technical Vocational Education Program (TVEP) Reauthorization

WHEREAS, the Alaska Association for Career & Technical Education (Alaska ACTE) is the state's only member-driven organization for career and technical education (CTE) professionals;

WHEREAS, the mission of Alaska ACTE is to provide leadership to ensure all students have access to quality CTE;

WHEREAS, in a challenging budget environment, fully-funding education, workforce development, and training programs must be a budget priority by our state to assure all Alaskans have access to gain the necessary skills for career opportunities;

WHEREAS, the Technical and Vocational Education Program (TVEP) has proven to be integral to maintaining technical training programs at training centers across the state;

WHEREAS, the TVEP program is up for reauthorization starting July 1, 2020;

WHEREAS, the TVEP program is funded through employee contributions to the state's unemployment fund and not from state general funds;

WHEREAS, Alaska ACTE considers TVEP to be essential to providing technical training programs across the state;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Alaska ACTE supports the reauthorization of the TVEP program for at least five years and requests the Alaska legislature continue funding this essential program.
