APPLICATION

OVERVIEW: The Kentucky Association for Career and Technical Education (KACTE), the professional association for Career and Technical Education (CTE) teachers and administrators at all instructional levels and among all program-area teaching disciplines, annually awards two scholarship grants for students pursuing CTE studies in Kentucky postsecondary institutions. A one-time, \$500 grant is awarded to a high school senior who is entering college, and another one-time, \$500 grant is awarded to a postsecondary student who is continuing college studies.

The grant program is named after Kentucky's legendary U.S. Congressman Carl D. Perkins who chaired the U.S. House of Representatives Education Committee for many years and was the driving force in creation of the Job Corps. KACTE's Carl Perkins Assistantship Grant honors the Congressman's life-long commitment to creating opportunity for young people to create better lives for themselves and their families. The grant is administered by a committee of KACTE board members. The award is announced and presented each year at the CTE Summer Program in Louisville, Ky.

Students interested in applying for the Carl Perkins Assistantship Scholarship should complete the application in full and submit to KACTE by the deadline.
