

**All participants must complete each written module exam (offered via NCCER online testing system) with a 70% or higher to receive their NCCER ICTP certification. There will be an opportunity to retest, if needed.

NCCER REGISTRATION AND DOCUMENTATION: Each participant must register with NCCER Registry to receive an NCCER ID#. Complete the New Registry Document with all information requested. Notify instructors when New Registry Document has been completed.
