  - Committee members were invited to attend the first-timer virtual session if available. The virtual session is replacing the former in-person breakfast which was part of previous in-person CareerTech VISION conferences.
- Business Meeting & Opening Session Thursday, Dec 2 (11:00 12:00)
  - A reminder was provided that the Business Meeting and Opening Session was decided by the committee to be combined, and held in-person only. The location is Room 392 of the Ernest N. Morial Convention Center. After rich discussion, Eric will purchase gift cards and tickets to provide to attendees as a give-away. It was recommended by the committee that the practice of providing gift cards be reevaluated in the preparation of next year's division budget and to consider possible replacements/ideas.
- Hospitality Room Friday, Dec 3 (10:00 5:00) Drinks Only
  - The Administration Division is partnering with the New, Related Services and Career Counseling Division to host the hospitality room. Due to COVID precautions, only water, coffee, tea, and soda will be provided. Committee members were encouraged to stop in and visit with attendees.

## 2021 National Policy Seminar Plans

- Scheduled for March 21-23, 2022, the conference looks to be held in-person, with potential for online participation. There are some legislative offices that have not resumed in-person meetings, which could impact the agenda for the conference. It was noted that the Administration Division and NCLA have partnered to cost-share (50/50) a reception for NPS Attendees, and that NCLA Board of Directors has approved continuing this if the conference is held in-person. This will be further discussed during the January/February policy committee meeting.
