

TIVA Best of Texas Awards Program

Purpose:

To recognize senior career and technical education students (CTE) who are doing an outstanding job worthy of recognition. It is essential to provide a tangible incentive for people to excel and for others to strive to reach the point of recognition.

Rules and Regulations:

- Complete the Official Nomination Form for the appropriate category. **Application must be typed.**
- Student award nominees **may only be** nominated by their CTE program instructor unless otherwise noted. **A nominator may nominate more than one student in their respective program area.**
- The nominator **must be** an active member of TIVA
- Students nominated **must be** an active member of SkillsUSA

***If all items are not completed according to the Rules and Regulations the student's application will not be considered.**

TIVA Best of Texas Awards:

Student Awards:

- Outstanding Student by Program Area
An outstanding student in a CTE program
- Outstanding Uniquely Challenged
An outstanding CTE student with a physical or mental disability
- Outstanding Special Achievement
An outstanding CTE student who has overcome major obstacles due to personal circumstances

One student from each of the above categories will be recognized and awarded scholarship money.

Student Awards Application Procedures-student award applications must contain the following:

- A one-page resume, by the student, that describes involvement in their CTE youth organization, other school and community activities, employment (if applicable) and educational goals.
- An official transcript with current GPA (Use 4.0 scale).
- Student statement (not to exceed 200 words) that describes the benefits career and technical education has provided.
- Educator/Nominator's statement (not to exceed 250 words) describing the traits that distinguish this individual from others in terms of ability, motivation, achievement, performance and contribution.
- High-quality photo. Photo will be used in the press releases.

- Two Letters of Support
- Parent/Guardian signed photo release form

In addition to the above information for student awards, the Uniquely Challenged application must include:

- A description of nominee's disability. This can be written by the nominee or the nominator.

In addition to the above information for student awards, the Special Achievement application must include:

- Descriptions of obstacles overcome by nominee. This can be written by the nominee or the nominator.

There will be one student chosen in each student category. All nominees will receive a letter to let them know if they were chosen or if they were not selected.
