Clerical and support staff are not used to determine 100 percent KACTE membership.

To qualify for the **Association for Career and Technical Education (ACTE) Achieve 100 Award** and recognition in *Techniques Magazine*, please submit an application by February 1, 2023. KACTE unified membership, which includes ACTE membership, must be current and paid by December 31, 2022. The application is here:

KACTE/ACTE unified professional dues are \$120. Individuals who are first-time members may pay an initial \$99 membership fee. If new members are paying on line, the system will charge a credit card for \$120, and KACTE will refund \$21 to the new member.
