

# Teach CTE Summit 2023



## Sponsorship Opportunity

**Purpose/Overview:** ACTE is planning to host its second Teach CTE Summit June 27-29 in St. Paul, MN (full conference June 28-29 with pre-conference activities on June 27). The CTE teacher recruitment and retention challenges that impact our field have been magnified by the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. Teacher pipeline threats extend to administrators and other personnel and are threatening programs and student success in both secondary and postsecondary education.

This solutions-based event is anticipated to be twice as large as the first Summit held in February 2020 with 200 attendees expected. Partners will benefit from being associated with an issue that personally impacts CTE educators and their students.
