  - Provides additional *benefits* to both businesses and consumers



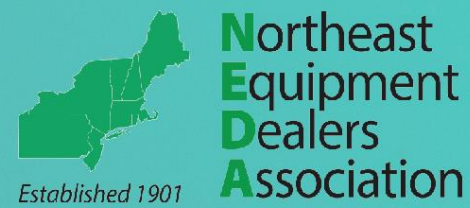
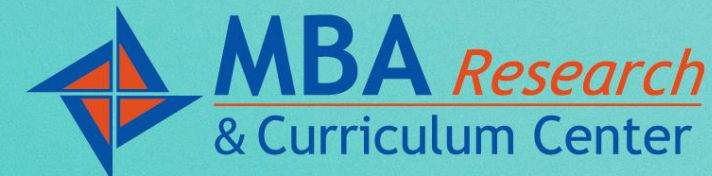
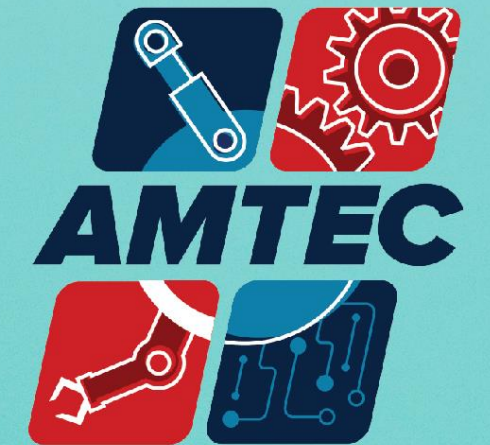
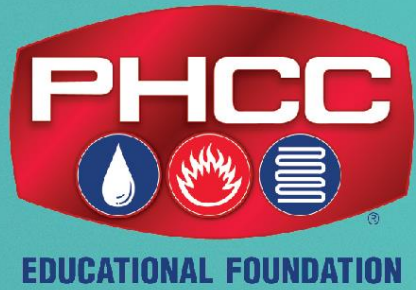
