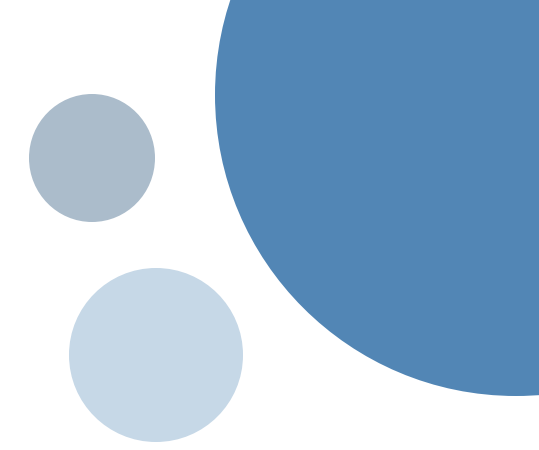
State Network CTE - BIG Picture
