

# CTE in Nevada



Career and technical education (CTE) programs equip students with the skills and experience necessary to pursue careers in key Nevada industries such as:



hospitality, tourism, sports, and creative



aerospace and defense



natural resources



water technologies

In 2024, 78% of Nevada postsecondary CTE concentrators earned a recognized postsecondary credential.

Many students are already enrolled in CTE in Nevada, developing technical, academic and employability skills and engaging in work-based learning experiences with industry partners.


