

# CTE in Wyoming

Career and technical education (CTE) programs equip students with the skills and experience necessary to pursue careers in key Wyoming industries such as:



outdoor products



advanced manufacturing



agricultural innovation



nuclear energy

In 2024, 69% of Wyoming secondary CTE concentrators graduated with an industry-recognized credential.

Many students are already enrolled in CTE in Wyoming, developing technical, academic and employability skills and engaging in work-based learning experiences with industry partners.


