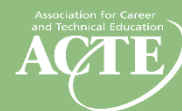


CTE in Louisiana



Career and technical education (CTE) programs equip students with the skills and experience necessary to pursue careers in key Louisiana industries such as:



logistics



life sciences



process industries



technology

In 2024, nearly 83% of Louisiana high school CTE concentrators earned a recognized postsecondary credential.

Many students are already enrolled in CTE in Louisiana, developing technical, academic and employability skills and engaging in work-based learning experiences with industry partners.

38,934

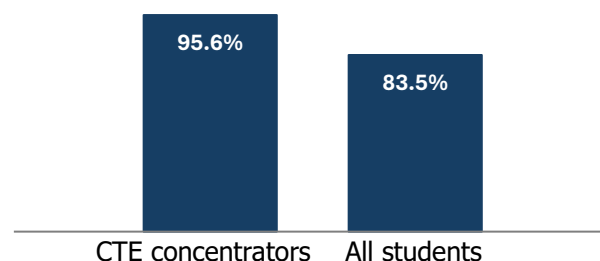
postsecondary CTE participants
